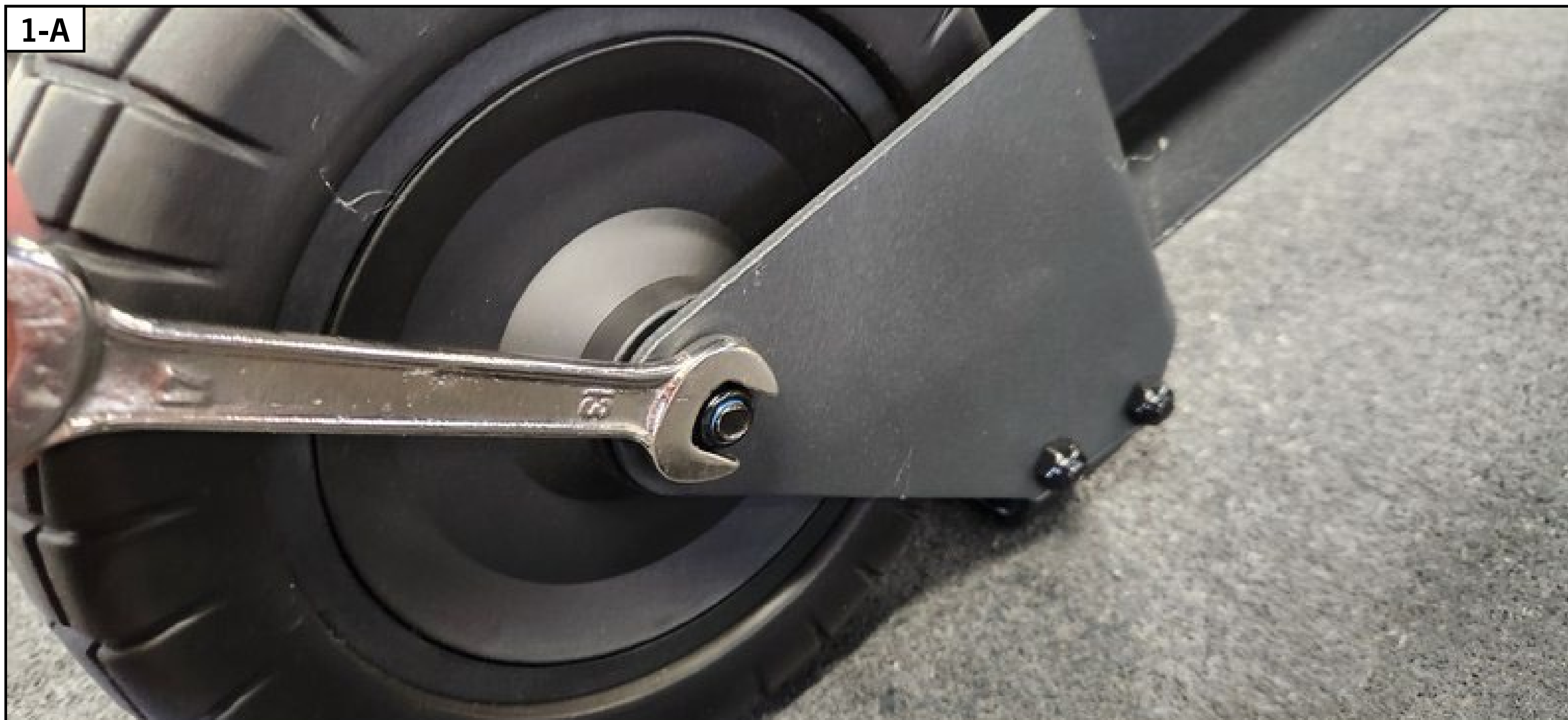
STEP 1 - LOOSEN NUT

Tools Required:

- T27 Wrench
- 13mm Socket or Wrench

- Use a **13mm Wrench** and a **T27 Wrench** to loosen the nut.
- Ensure the bolt is threaded all of the way through the nut.
- If the problem persists, contact customer service and a new turf tire will be provided.
